First Call for Abstracts

TO: Members of the Academy and Science Community

The forty-fifth Annual Fall Scientific Paper Session of the Rochester Academy of Science will be hosted by the State University of New York at Geneseo (SUNY Geneseo) on **Saturday, November 10, 2018**, from 8:30 a.m. to 2 p.m. Oral presentations and poster sessions will begin at 9:30 a.m. The luncheon is at 12:30 p.m. and will be followed by the Larry King Memorial Lecture.

This session provides a forum for Academy members, the collegiate community and others engaged in scientific research to present the results of their investigations in an atmosphere that promotes discussion and interaction. Undergraduate students, graduate students, and faculty members are encouraged to attend and to present posters or oral reports.

You do not have to be a member of the Rochester Academy of Sciences to participate.

The Academy covers the full scope of basic and applied sciences, including but not limited to **anthropology, biology, botany, chemistry, computer science, ecology, environmental science, geography, geology, physics, physiology, science education, and zoology.**

Presentations may be oral presentations or posters. Posters provide an excellent opportunity for author-audience interaction, and students should consider this mode of presentation, particularly if this will be their first scientific meeting.

Refreshments will be provided throughout the morning. Attendees may purchase a lunch ticket during registration. A map of the SUNY Geneseo campus, luncheon information, and registration details will be included in the second call, which will be distributed at the end of August.



Submission Guidelines

The deadline for submitting abstracts is 5:00 Monday, October 22, 2018.

We cannot guarantee that late submissions will be included.

Instructions for registration and abstract submission will be included in the second call for abstracts, which will be distributed in August.

Abstract books will be available digitally. Paper copies of the abstract book will be available by request only.

Abstract Format

Abstracts submission and registration will be via a google form, distributed in August.

Poster Format

We will have poster easels with backing boards to display posters that are on a single sheet of paper or on poster paper. Posters can be no larger than 48 inches x 38 inches.

Presentation format

Oral presentations are limited to 12 minutes in length. There will be 3 minutes for questions from the audience at the end of your presentation. Please bring your presentation as a powerpoint file (.pptx) on a flash drive.
